

## Spanish Cross in Silver Steinhauer & Lück Lüdenscheid

### Description

The famous Steinhauer & Lück Company manufactured the Spanish Cross during the war. This one is showing the incused mark 4, stamped on the pin. This post 1941 cross was made in tombac and silvered. It is a private purchase. The attachment system, hinge and pin, are typical. The hinge is an EK type. The hook is of a square section. Note the 2 cut-out arms in each eagle's swastika.

The Spanish Cross (Spanienkreuz) was instituted on April, 14th 1935 by A. Hitler (14.4.1939, RGBI. IS.1939, 1360). The silver class was awarded 327 times during the main Legion Condor return parades in Hamburg and Döberitz, which make this award rare.
